


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Year 3 & 4 Cadbury World Trip Friday 17th May '19



Dear parents/carers,

As you are aware, our topic focusses on chocolate this term. In light of this, I have arranged for Year 3 and 4 to visit **Cadbury World on Friday 17th May**. The children seem to be incredibly excited at the prospect of this, as are the staff!

While we are there, we will be exploring the museum and visiting the exciting exhibits on offer, as well as enjoying the 4D cinema experience, factory tour and (hopefully) tasting lots of samples! The children will also take part in a session on the Mayans to learn about how and why chocolate played an important role in this ancient civilisation.

Children will need to be at school for **8am**, ready to depart for the world of chocolate by 8:30am. We will then leave Cadbury World at approximately 3:30pm, giving us a traffic-dependent ETA of **4:45pm** at the bus stop in Isham (text updates will be sent to keep you informed of our ETA on the day).

Year 3 & 4 will need to wear full school uniform. They will need to take with them a **packed lunch** in a **small backpack**, along with **snacks and drinks** for the coach journeys if they wish. Please ensure they have enough to drink for the day and don't rely on refilling water bottles. However, please be aware that there are **no cloakroom/storage facilities** for us during our visit so children will be expected to carry their things around with them all day. We will not be outside for any length of time so, in order to save us carrying it around, we will not be taking a coat. Children therefore must take a **jumper/cardigan** with them. Children may also bring a small amount of **money for the gift shop** (£5 maximum) if they wish.

In order that we can run this trip, we ask for a voluntary donation of **£21.10 per child** which has been set up on ParentPay for your ease. The generous donations received during our Autumn and Spring project afternoon has significantly reduced the cost – thank you.

As always, we rely on the voluntary contributions and, should sufficient funds not be raised, the trip may not go ahead.
