Year 6



Within this curriculum overview, you will find more information about what your child will be covering throughout the Summer Term in order to support them further at home, if you wish to do so. This term, year 6 are learning about:

Invaders are coming (History and Geography based)

By the end of the term, the children will be able to:

- Look at a map of the world, focusing on European and Scandinavian countries, and list regions that were part of the Anglo Saxon and Viking land.
- Identify and name famous Vikings.
- Look at old maps and buildings in the local area and include a local history study linked to Northampton Vikings.
- Use dates and vocabulary relating to the passing of time, struggles and raids up to 1066.
- Research about voyages, invasions and how trade/living altered the use of land.
- Compare aspects of modern day life to how they lived in the Anglo and Viking period.

Writing

Additionally this theme will be used to cover some of our writing objectives.

By the end of the term, children will be able to:

- Write a sequel to a well-known story.
- Compare different types of texts and genres.
- Compose well-ordered paragraphs by focusing more on the planning stage of writing.
- Write a discursive piece of writing by understanding all viewpoints and coming to a conclusion based on the points raised within the piece of writing.
- Write a letter using formal language techniques.
- Write a persuasive piece in order to sway a reader one way or another.

Maths (will be taught separately)

By the end of the term, children will be able to:

- Solve problems involving ratio and proportion.
- Describe positions across four quadrants (co-ordinates).
- Draw and translate simple shapes across co-ordinates.
- Read the time on an analogue and digital clock.
- Read timetables that involve measuring the length of time.
